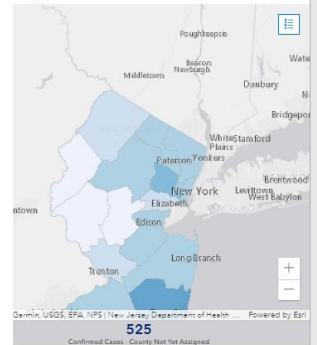

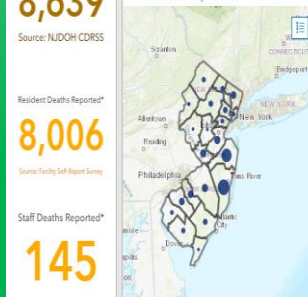
Understanding Life-Sustaining Treatments

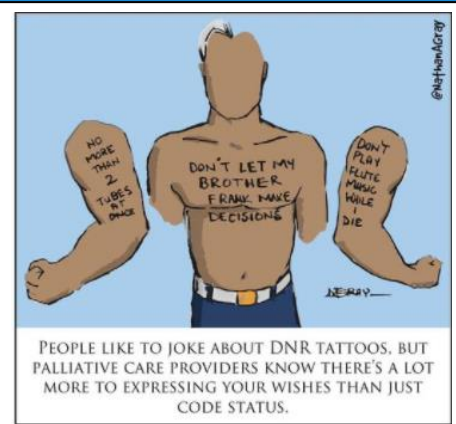
